	Oriented to the west, this duplex rests on a concrete foundation. Cream-colored stucco clads the exterior walls. Windows are generally 1-beside-1-light, sliding sash, with brown aluminum frames. Opening in west ends of the second story of both side (north and south) elevations are tripartite windows, with sliding side sashes and a fixed middle frame. A pair of doorways opens in the center of the north half and south half of the symmetrical front (west) facade. Both host 8-panel, tan-painted wood doors, opening behind white, vinyl-frame storm doors. Concrete stoops approach both doors. Opening in either end of the rear (east) elevation's second story are plate-glass sliding doors. They provide access to wood decks with simple, wood balustrades. Brown asphalt shingles cover the side-gabled roof. Brown-painted wood fascia and soffit box the eaves.

Setbacks from West 15th Street are generally the same on this block. This property is situated on the north side of West 15th Street, between 1505-1507 North Elizabeth Street to the east and 615 West 15th Street to the west. Gravel covers the yard, which is terraced behind (east of) the house. Filling the area

42. Statement of significance:

Because this property is less than 50 years old and does not meet any of criteria considerations A through G, it is ineligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Moreover, the architectural and historical significance are not to the extent that the property would qualify for individual listing in the Colorado State Register of Historic Properties or as a City of Pueblo landmark. Given its age, the property should not be considered a contributing resource within any potential historic district.

43. Assessment of historic physical integrity related to significance:

Constructed around 1981, this duplex exhibits a high level of physical integrity relative to the seven aspects of integrity as defined by the National Park Service and the Colorado Historical Society: location, setting, design, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association. It has not been notably altered since its construction.

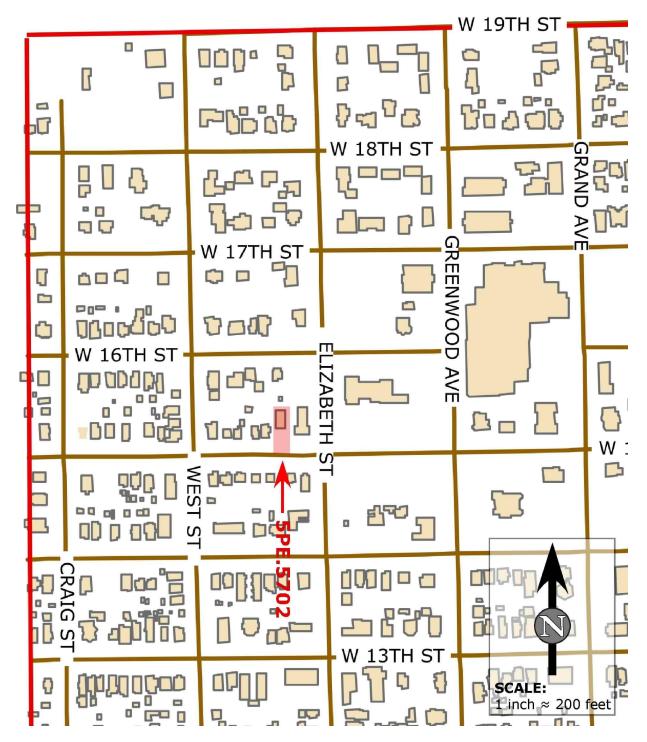

SITE SKETCH MAP



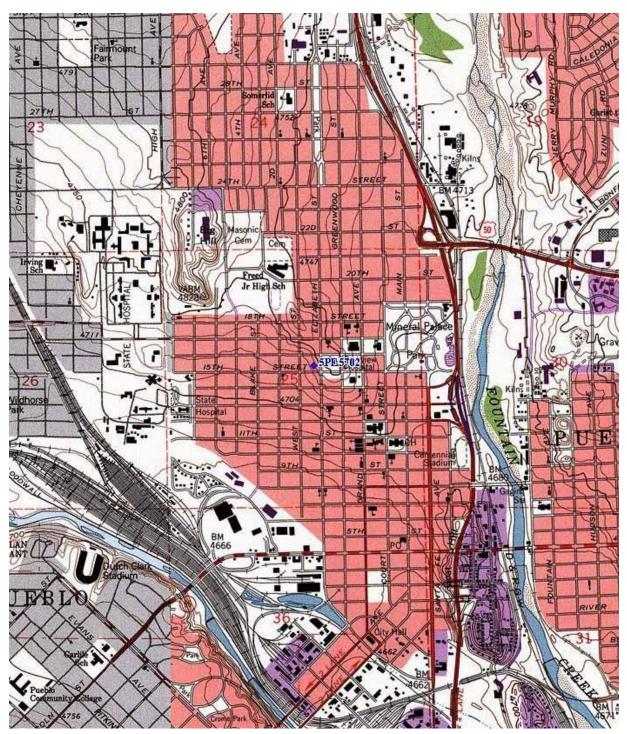
