A semi-circular, concrete driveway is located on the northeast corner of the lot. The back yard is terraced, with railroad-tie retaining walls, encircled by a wood privacy fence.

Because this property is less than 50 years old and does not meet any of criteria considerations A through G, it is ineligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Moreover, the architectural and historical significance are not to the extent that the property would qualify for individual listing in the Colorado State Register of Historic Properties or as a City of Pueblo landmark. Given its age, the property should not be considered a contributing resource within any potential historic district.

43. Assessment of historic physical integrity related to significance:

Constructed in 1995, this duplex exhibits a high level of physical integrity relative to the seven aspects of integrity as defined by the National Park Service and the Colorado Historical Society: location, setting, design, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association. It has not been notably altered since its construction. This property retains sufficient physical integrity to convey its architectural and historical significance.

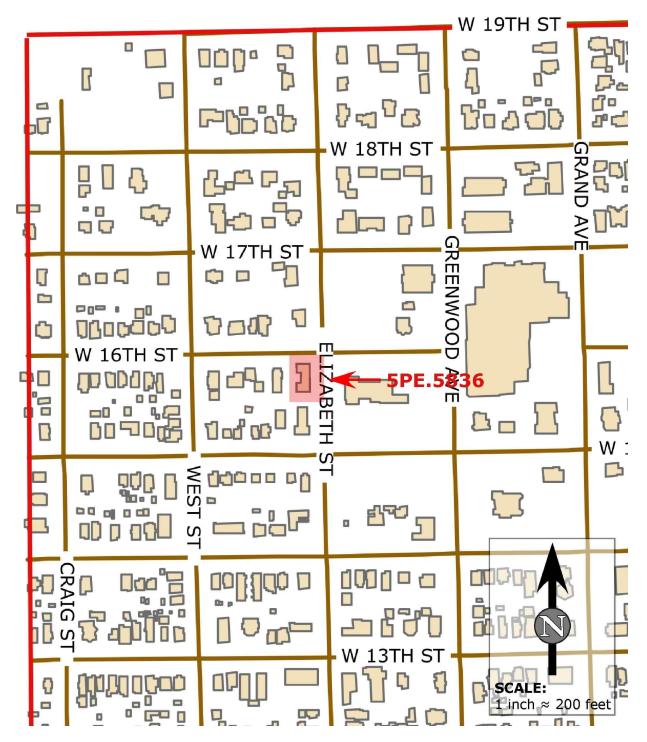

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SITE SKETCH MAP

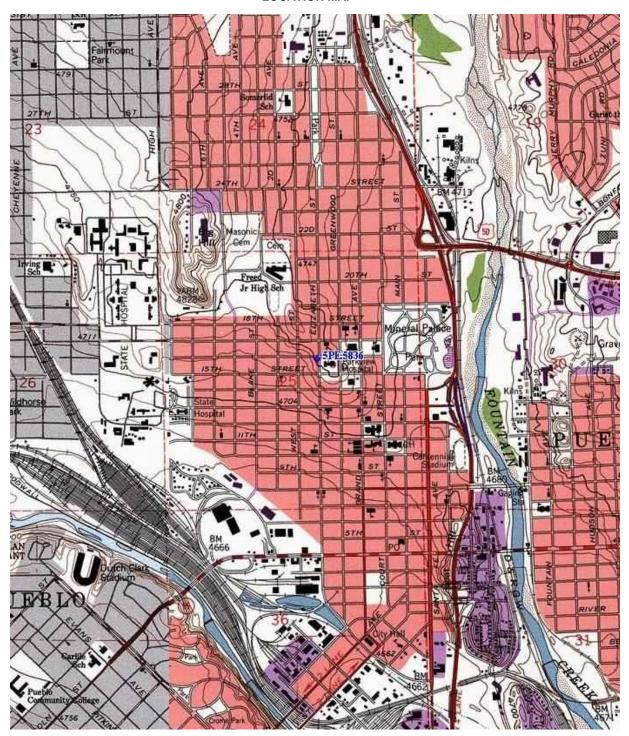


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LOCATION MAP
