

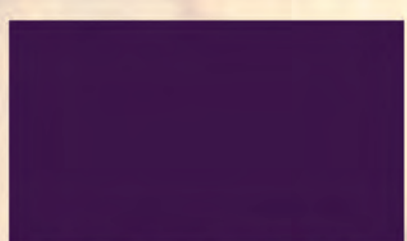
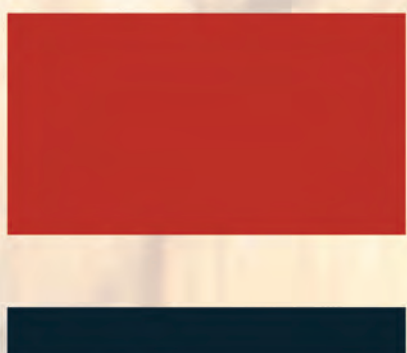

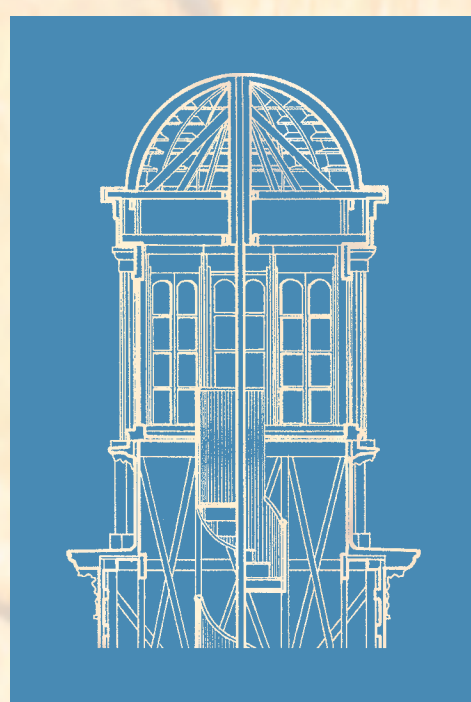
Detail of a carving on the front door of the Marycrest Motherhouse proclaiming "*Pax et Bonum*" or "Peace and Goodness."
