

1917 Sisters of St. Francis first arrive in Denver and teach at St. Elizabeth's School

Midwestern (or Sacred Heart) Province of the Sisters of St. 1938 Francis created and headquartered in Denver 1938 Mother Lidwina Jacobs acquires the former J.B. Walker estate, "Willowcrest," in northwest Denver, for \$25,000 Sisters purchase the adjacent Painter property, including its 1950 mansion, on Federal Boulevard **1954** First section of the Motherhouse completed and opened Remainder of the Motherhouse built 1958 All-girls Marycrest High School opens in old Painter House 1958 New Marycrest High School building constructed 1960 Our Lady of Lourdes Shrine completed 1963 Damen Hall, a home for at-risk mothers and their children, 1963 started Adult Education Tutorial Program established 1964 Peak of women taking vows, with 26 at Marycrest alone 1966 1968 Queen of Peace Oratory House of Prayer constructed Marycrest Emergency Housing program established
